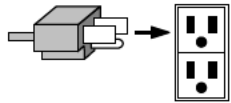
Startup Procedure



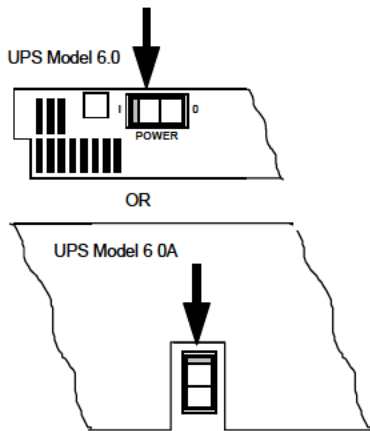
CAUTIONS

DO NOT perform this Startup Procedure on a workstation that has never been powered up before. The System Administrator must startup new stations.

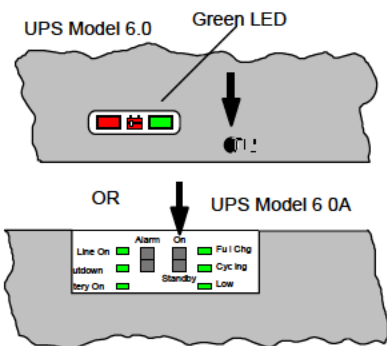
Ensure that all components are connected before performing this Startup Procedure.



1 Plug in the main power source for the tester.



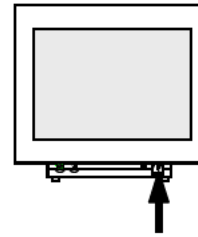
2 Power on the UPS Main Power Switch with the switch at the rear of the UPS.



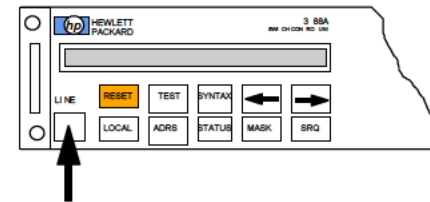
3 Switch the UPS from STANDBY to ON with the switch on the front of the UPS. Use a screwdriver on the Model 6.0 to hold the switch down until you hear a beep and the green LED lights. The UPS will take a few seconds to power up the Sun CPU. The CPU beeps after power up.

4 Power on the monitor with

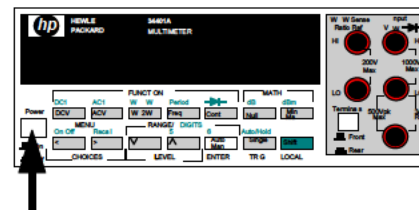
the switch on the front of the monitor.



5 Power on the HP 3488A Switch/Control Unit with the switch on the front of the 3488.



switch in to



6 Power on the HP 34401A Digital Multimeter with the switch on the front of the 34401. Press the "Terminals"

select "Rear".
7 Wait for Login: prompt to appear on the monitor.

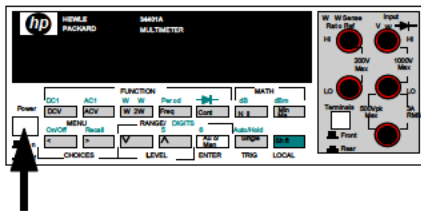

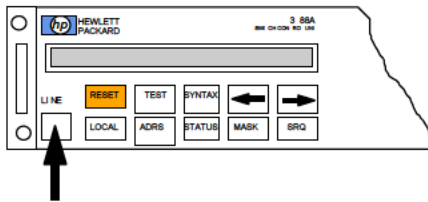
Shutdown Procedure

1 In any "vikop" window, type:
`sudo init 0`

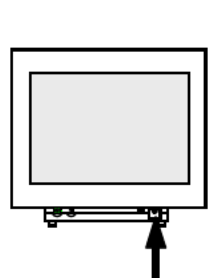
2 At the Password: prompt, type:
<your password>



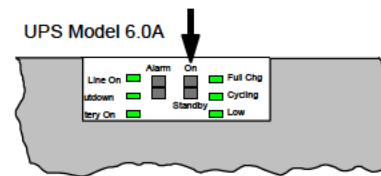
3 When the the OK> prompt appears on the monitor, power off the HP 34401A Digital Multimeter with the switch on the front of the 34401.



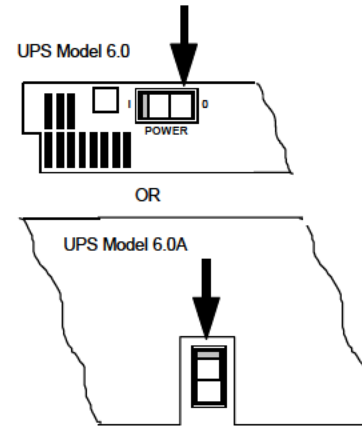
4 Power off the HP 3488A Switch/Control Unit with the switch on the front of the 3488.



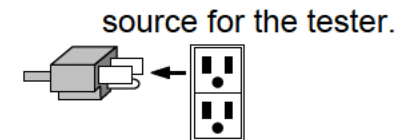
5 Power off the monitor with the switch on the front of the monitor.



6 On the UPS Model 6.0A, switch the UPS from ON to STANDBY with the switch on the front of the UPS.



7 Power off the UPS Main Power Switch with the switch at the rear of the UPS.



8 Unplug the main power
