How to Get a Map

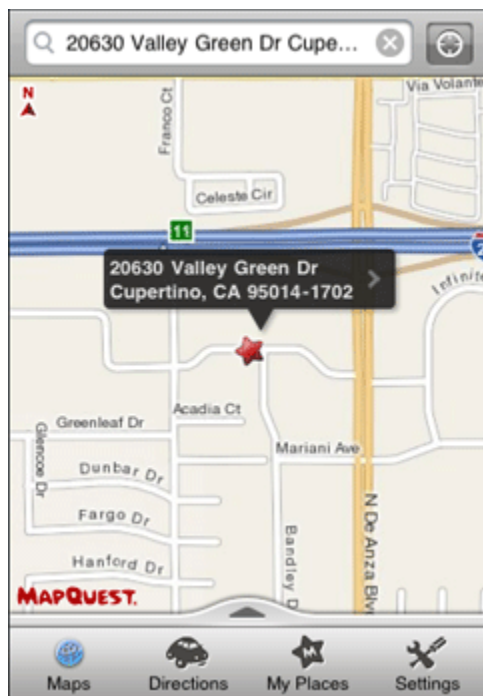
To get a map, open the MapQuest® 4 Mobile application and follow the directions in one of the following help topics to map your current location, enter a location, or select a saved or recent location:

How to Clear the Map

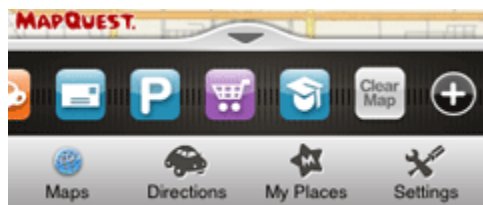
To clear the map:

1. Tap the **(X)** at the end of the text box, or tap the arrow to display the Carousel:



Flick to scroll the Carousel to the left until you can see the **Clear Map** icon.

2. Tap **Clear Map**. The MapQuest star is removed from the map.



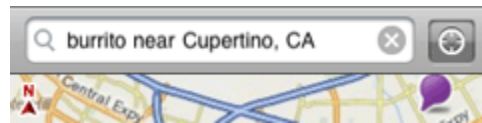
How to Use My Current Location

If you have a GPS chip in your mobile device, you can tap the **Find Me** icon to show your approximate location on a map or in relation to a mapped route. You can also select **Current Location** for starting and ending locations when creating maps (see [How to Get a Map](#)) and directions (see [How to Get Directions](#)).

Using Find Me

To use Find Me:

1. Get a map or directions.
2. Tap the **Find Me** icon.



Your approximate location is indicated by the **My Location** icon.

Note: You can change the **My Location** icon from the default waving man to another icon or a picture. Tap **Settings**, and then tap **My Position Icon**.

Using Current Location

When creating directions, **Current Location** is listed as an option when you tap the text box. Tap **Current Location** to use your approximate location as a starting or ending point.



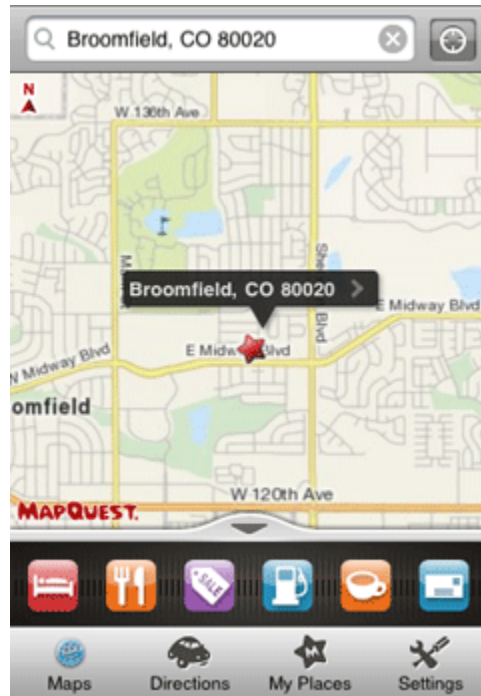

How to Get the Location Options

When you get a map, the location summary is displayed in a bubble on the screen. You can open the **Location Options** menu to quickly get directions to or from this location or share this location.

1. Get a map.



2. Tap the location bubble.
The options screen is displayed.



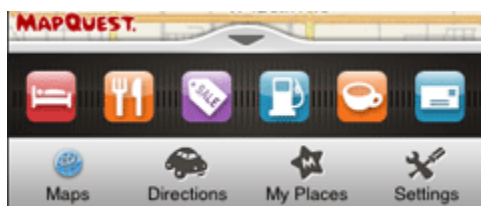
3. Tap the map thumbnail to return to the map, or tap **Directions To Here**, **Directions From Here**, or **Share This Location**.

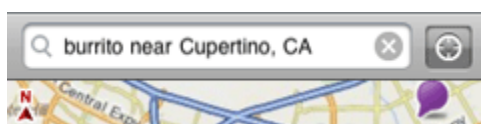
How to Get a Map Using My Current Location

To get a map using your current location:

1. Tap the **Maps** icon in the navigation bar at the bottom of the screen.

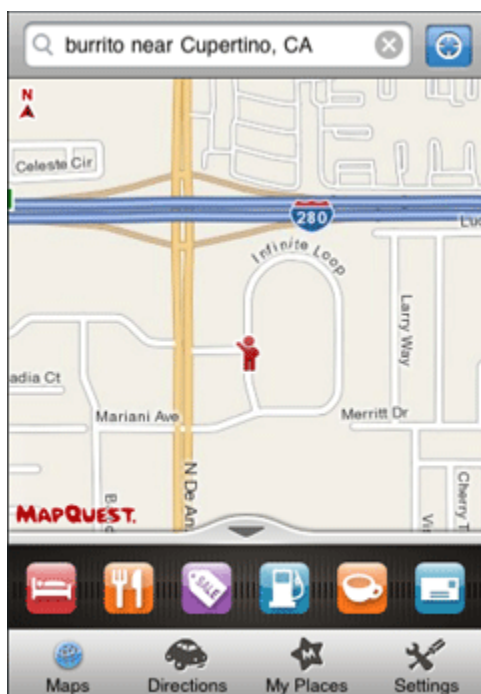


2. Tap the **Find Me** icon.



Within a few seconds, the map is displayed.

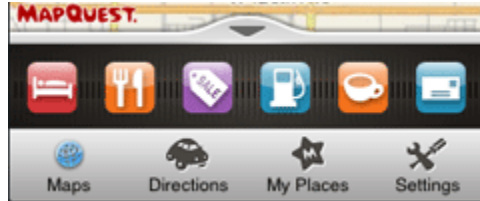
The **My Location** icon indicates your current position.



How to Get a Map with an Entered Location

To get a map using entered locations:

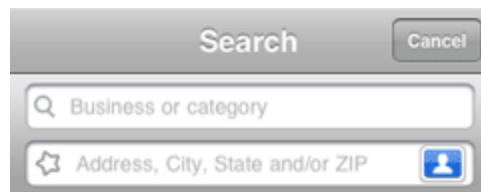
1. Tap the **Maps** icon in the navigation bar at the bottom of the screen.



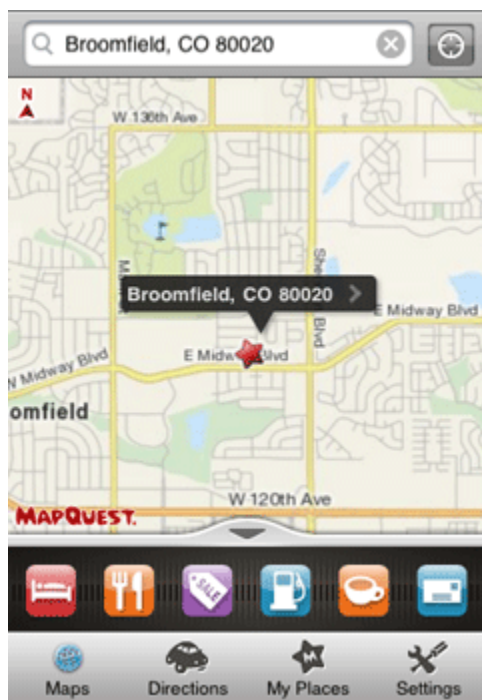
2. Tap the **Search for business or address** text field. The on-screen keyboard is displayed.
3. Use the on-screen keyboard to enter as much address information as you know (for example, 2050 S Gaylord Denver CO or simply 80202).

Note: You do not have to use punctuation when entering address information.

4. Tap **Search**.



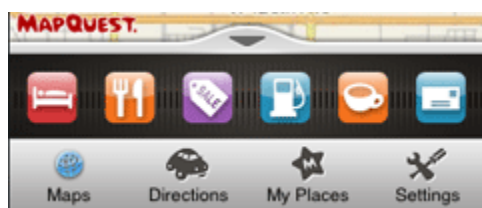
Within a few seconds, the map is displayed. The MapQuest Star icon indicates the location you entered.



How to Get a Map Using Saved & Recent Locations

To get a map using saved and recent locations:

1. Tap the **Maps** icon in the navigation bar at the bottom of the screen.



2. Tap the **Search for business or address** text field. The on-screen keyboard is displayed.
3. Tap the **Business or category** text field or the **Address, City, State and/or ZIP** text field. **Recent locations** are displayed.
